Jesus addresses His disciples saying, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." We are Jesus' disciples, and He is speaking those same words to us here and now.

Living a life of discipleship is not always easy. It requires us to be imitators of Christ — who suffered, died, and rose from the dead out of total love for each one of us. This means we are called to share in Christ's sufferings by taking up our cross and following Him daily.

But what does this look like in our day-to-day lives?

We can start by making a firm resolution to follow Christ today, here and now, and renewing that resolution each day when we rise. This requires time with Him each day — speaking and listening.

We should also strive to pick up our crosses each day with Christ by our side. Our cross might be suffering from an illness, fighting an addiction, a day of screaming kids, or a period where things just don't seem to go our way. Instead of

avoiding these sufferings or complaining about them, we are called to carry them with Christ, allowing Him to transform us through them.

If we live life constantly focused on us, we will ultimately lose ourselves, but if we surrender our lives for Christ and His mission, we will gain eternal life and become more alive than we could have ever imagined, "For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it." This takes daily commitment and requires endurance in our faith, which can only be done through active discipleship.



All donations will benefit **Alpha Center for Women**, an Ocala pregnancy resource center that offers life-affirming alternatives to abortion, material support during and after pregnancy, post-abortion recovery and a mentoring program for parents in need. From 2006 to present, the generous parishioners of Blessed Trinity have contributed over \$128,300! Last year we ministered to 162 new clients providing pregnancy tests and meeting material needs through our Bridges program. Over 1,500 client visits took place and we assisted our moms and dads with nearly 22,500 closet items (diapers, wipes, clothing, food, and furniture, as well as utility assistance, gas and grocery gift cards). In addition, your support has allowed us to continue our sponsorship of two Uganda students and the Uganda Orphanage.

Faith and Science: Perhaps there's more than meets the eye.....

In his recent book, Christ, Reason and Science, Father Robert Spitzer reviews scientific research into the Shroud of Turin, Eucharistic miracles and the inexplicable physical healings that have been recorded at Lourdes and suggests that there is much more alignment between faith and reason than we are sometimes led to believe. The latest scientific analysis of the Shroud does suggest that it is 2,000 years old and that it's fibers contain evidence of the AB blood type that is the same as the found in Eucharistic miracles. The medical bureau at Lourdes has approved very few miracles but those it has recognized have been exhaustively reviewed over many years and are extremely well documented. Father Spitzer's book offers a thorough review of these important instances where genuine science has come to recognize that there is much more to these unexplained phenomena than critics of our faith are willing to consider. His book is an invitation to look at the scientific evidence, which is there for all to see. In his introduction he offers an historical perspective on the origins of Catholic faith. I highly recommend this volume, which is extremely well written and most informative. Available from the Gift Shop this weekend, cost \$20. Dr Barry Meehan

Both were very impressed by the care received by the children from the dedicated sisters and volunteers. 


