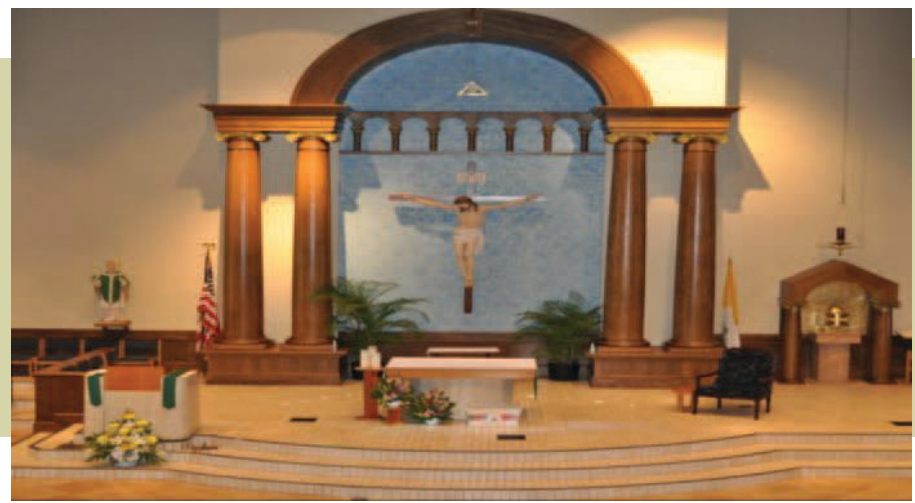

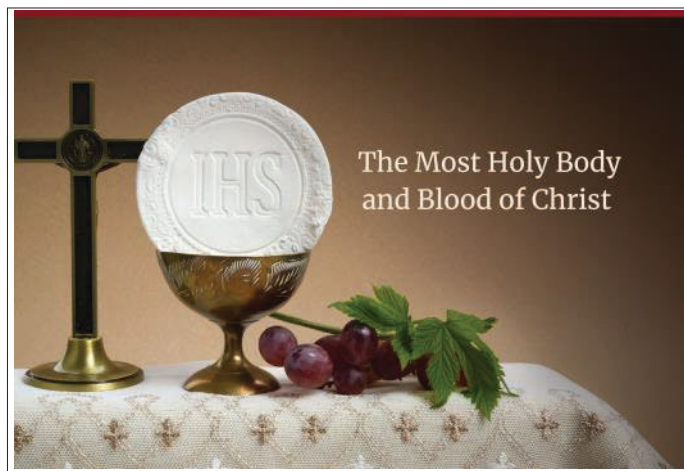

Grant us hearts of a steward: hearts that are filled with gratitude, eager to share, and long to give back to you.

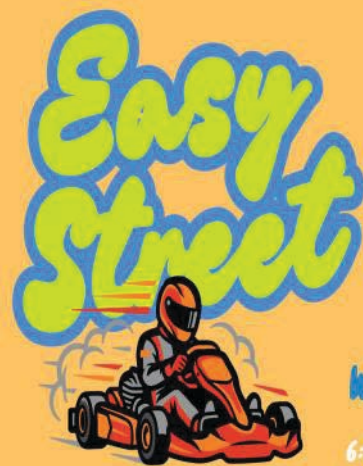
Grant us hearts filled with your Spirit: hearts open to conversion, filled with hope, and on fire with your Word.

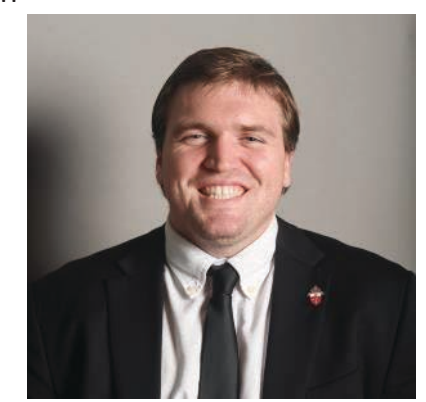

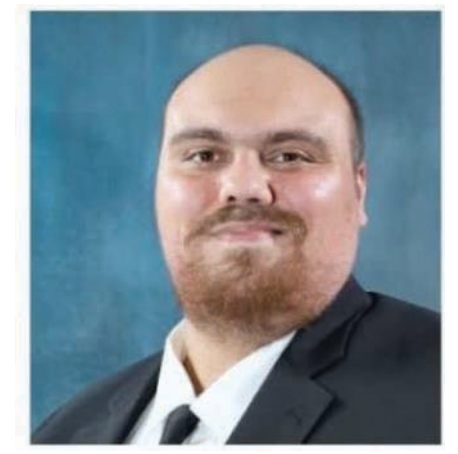

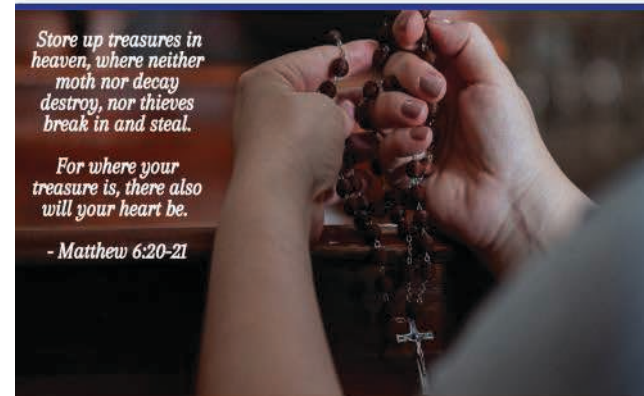

## Understanding Stewardship in a Complex World

In Saint John's Gospel, Jesus alludes to the lives of action his disciples will lead. He speaks to God about his followers: "I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one" (John 17:15). As a communion of Christian stewards, we live out Catholic faith in a challenging world.

We see overwhelming problems and social ills, and we're bombarded from so many sides to take action. We are sometimes hit by "compassion fatigue," and often the issues are complex and our response unsure. However, we know that our Catholic faith is a communal faith, not meant to be lived in isolation. Our prayer and spirituality serve as a springboard to a life of Christian charity and service to others in some form or fashion.

There are a host of Catholic agencies that can help us better understand Catholic social teaching and how we apply that teaching to the complexity of world issues that surround us. Many times, news reports focus on the Church's position on one or two issues. But in reality, the bishops are very active and outspoken on a wide range of social concerns, and by joining with them as people of faith we can create a united front that promotes positive change and enhances the common good.



Through its teachings and programs, the USCCB addresses issues such as human trafficking, hunger among our nation's poor, employment, health care, the environment, education and capital punishment.
